



VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

All positions in the AYSO organization are volunteer. That means we need you!! To receive your \$10 discount per child (now or deferred) take a look at the volunteer positions below and select one or more of them. Sign up for the position(s) at the volunteer table during walk-in registration or circle & mail in.

Game Day Positions – Have a direct influence on skills and development of players. For U5/6 Coaches the commitment is 1 hour on game day. For U8 and older it is one 1 hour practice and games. Refs pick their own game schedules. All positions offer both online training and “classroom” training. Immediately receive your discount for these positions.

Coach – Free training, equipment and shirt. Coach your child plus one friend (note on registration form).

Referee – Free training and uniform. Get to really know the rules of the game. Pick your own schedule - choose to either ref your child's games (U8 and above) or ref other games so that you can just watch your child's game. Must attend two 4 hour ref classes for certification.

Youth Referee – Free training and uniform. Become a better player yourself by getting to really know the rules of the game. Must be 10 years old by the start of the season to ref U8 games. Must attend one 4 hour ref class for certification. Pick your own schedule week-to-week.

Assistant Coach – Free training if requested. Ass't coach on your child's team.



Board Positions – Attend 6 board meetings per year. Be available by email for most job requirements. Attend other functions as needed such as registration and coaches meetings. These positions have time-sensitive due dates that are critical for our organization to run smoothly. Your commitment to follow-thru on the position needs to be stressed.

Receive one free registration for becoming a board member.

Coach Administrator – Ensure the coaches are ready to start the season. Coordinate the August coaches meeting. Duties include mailing postcards to coaches, compiling coach packets from multiple sources (schedules, rosters, general info, etc), creating email group for coaches, purchasing coach supplies in time for the meeting, and attending the meeting. The Coach Admin also sets up, but doesn't run, coach training, ensuring the location and trainers are assigned. This position is an administrative position that doesn't require knowledge of soccer rules.

Volunteer Coordinator – Point of contact for volunteers that need to change dates/times and handle volunteer additions. Make reminder calls for upcoming volunteer events (coaches meeting, coaches table, registration, etc)

Field Coordinator – Ensure all field equipment is delivered (via our trailer) to the coaches table at Douglas Walker by 8:15 and picked up sometime after games are completed. Must have a trailer hitch to haul the trailer. Work with the current field coordinator this next fall/spring season, with a commitment to take over the following Fall 2012 season.
